NJ Family Care is free or low-cost health insurance for uninsured children and certain low-income parents.

To be eligible for NJ Family Care, applicants must:

- Live in New Jersey
- Be a US citizen or qualified immigrant whose documents allow them to remain here permanently.
- Be a child age 18 or younger, or the parent of a child 18 or younger.
- Meet the rules of the program

Family must have the following documentation:

- Family includes adoptive or natural parents and their spouses, children under 21, or guardians (if there are no parents.)
- Names and birthdates
- Social Security numbers for those applying
- Information about other health insurance
- Information about income.
