Alcoholic Beverages on School Premises

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SCHOOL PREMISES

The knowing possession, without legal authority, or knowing consumption of any alcoholic beverage by any person on school premises is a disorderly persons offense.

The Board of Education prohibits the possession and consumption of an alcoholic beverage by any person in any school building and on the school property.

The Superintendent will report to law enforcement officials and prosecute as appropriate any person who violates law and this policy. Any pupil who possesses or uses or is under the influence of alcohol on school premises will be treated in accordance with the requirements of school law for assessment and evaluation.

School district employees who violate this policy or are present on school premises or at any school sponsored activity while under the influence of alcohol will be subject to discipline, which may include dismissal or certification of tenure charges, as appropriate.
