Thank you so much for all of your efforts in following the district guidelines posted on the district website and for taking the necessary precautions to keep our children healthy.

As we approach the cooler months of the year, flu season is inevitable. However, there are a few things we can do to help our children continue attending school in person. If your child is not feeling well, please keep him/her home. If there is a need for COVID 19 (SARS-CoV-2) testing due to two or more COVID-19 symptoms, please send all test results to the nurse. A lab dated Rapid or PCR test is preferred to a home test. In the event that a positive result is received, it is imperative that you immediately report this information to your school nurse or your building principal.

As we move forward, we must continue to wear masks, (if reusable, wash daily; if not, dispose of it), keep a backup mask in backpacks, wash hands or use hand sanitizer frequently, and be mindful of social distancing at all times. We may not be able to keep everyone healthy all of the time BUT, together, we can minimize the impact of whatever health issues await us over the next few months.
