

Parking Lot Etiquette



The safety and security of our children must be foremost in our minds during pick-up and drop-off hours. We ask for your patience and cooperation during this part of the day; especially, during the first few weeks of school and inclement weather. We ask that you be aware of and adhere to the procedures outlined below.

- ❖ Please pull as far up as possible in the pickup/drop off zone. This allows for maximum number of vehicles in the zone. Also be reminded that when you don't pull up, you are not allowing vehicles behind you to drive into the zone.
- ❖ Identification placards must be prominently displayed on the passenger side dashboard of your car to identify the student and family. Placards will be distributed to students on the first day of school.
- ❖ Park only in spaces designated for parking. Double parking is not permitted. Parking in no parking lanes creates congestion for both cars and school buses. If a space is not available, you will need to park on the street.
- ❖ Parking in the handicap spaces is only for those with a valid handicap sign.
- ❖ Please refrain from using cell phones while dropping off and picking up children. We have had some close calls in the lot as a result of distracted drivers and children/parents darting between cars.
- ❖ Always use the crosswalks when crossing to and from the parking lot. Remember – we are setting an example for our children at all times.
- ❖ If you are using the pick up/drop off line, you may not leave your car. Children should enter and exit the car via the passenger side of the vehicle.
- ❖ Turn off engines while waiting to pick-up and drop-off children. Our desire is to protect the health and well being of our children. Excessive emissions from idling are a threat to children's health. Current regulations limit engine idling for vehicles to three minutes.
