*All students attend Mary Kay McMillin Early Childhood Center, Columbia Middle School and Governor Livingston High School. Elementary Schools are districted as follows:*

**Mountain Park School**-Area bounded by the railroad, west side of Plainfield Avenue and the Township's westerly boundary, including Emerson Lane and Dogwood Lane areas.

**Thomas P. Hughes School**-Area of Murray Hill on the southern side of Mountain Avenue. Area bounded by the railroad, east side of Plainfield Avenue to Green Brook, Mountain Avenue to Holly Mews, Union Avenue to Snyder Avenue.

**William Woodruff School**-Area of Cinnamon Ridge. Diamond Hill Road to Valley Road, including Twin Falls, McMane Avenue and Glenside Avenue area. Area bound by the railroad, Snyder Avenue, Springfield Avenue, the Passaic River to the Township's easterly boundary.

**Bus Transportation**

1. Courtesy busing is provided to students attending the Mary Kay McMillin Early Childhood Center Grades K-1.
2. Students in grade 2-8 who live beyond two miles from their school are eligible for transportation.
3. Students in grades 6-8 who live beyond two miles from Columbia Middle School are eligible for transportation.
4. Students in grades 9-12 who live beyond two-and-a-half miles from Governor Livingston High School are eligible for transportation.
5. Both Google Maps and MapQuest are used to determine eligibility. Measurement is made by the shortest route via walking, driving or any combination of the two modes of travel.
