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Course Description:

This is an introductory class for all 6th grade artists. Students will move from elementary art toward more mature works. Course Requirements:

Art Foundations is a class provided to every 6th Grade student at Columbia Middle School to provide the knowledge and specific skills necessary to create a variety of different visual works of art.

Class Participation:

Actively participating in class means students are expected to contribute in class discussions and effectively participate in class activities. For a student to actively participate in class they should take part in class discussions and remain on task for assignments. Students should work consistently for the entire class period. This also includes active listening to others. Participation will be included in your grade. Points are assigned according to your participation in class activities and preparedness.

Grading:

All assignments are graded and are due by the end of the at the Marking Period

Student work is graded at the end of each assignment

An M (missing) or I (Incomplete) on powerschool indicates the assignment was not completed or turned in

Students may complete work at any time before the end of the marking period without penalty

Students may bring work home to complete if needed

Expectations:

-Arrive on time and prepared for class

-Respect classmates, teacher, and the school

-Work for the entire class period to the best of your ability

-Clean your work area and put supplies away before being dismissed

-Participate in class, actively listen to classmates

Note: if expectations are not met - first time- verbal warning, second time - phone call/email home and teacher detention, third time - office detention. Consequences can vary depending on severity of infraction.
