UNDERSTANDING THE PARCC SCORES-MATH SECTION

- The following slides are in response to questions raised regarding the release of comparative PARCC scoring information for NJ school districts.
- When comparing math scores between districts, it is important to consider the student populations that are represented in the test results.

UNDERSTANDING THE PARCC SCORES-MATH SECTION

- ELA testing is done based completely on grade level.
- Math testing is assessed by grade level until a student reaches Algebra.
- A student taking Algebra 1, Geometry, or Algebra 2 will take the PARCC assessment as determined by their course level regardless of their grade level.

A QUICK COMPARISON OF 8TH GRADE TEST TAKERS

- PARCC Consortium 8th grade test takers
 - 18% taking Algebra 1 or Geometry
 - •82% of eighth graders took Grade 8 math test
- NJ 8th grade test takers
 - 34% taking Algebra 1 or Geometry
 - •66% of eighth graders took Grade 8 math test
- Berkeley Heights 8th grade test takers
 - •62% taking Algebra 1 or Geometry
 - •38% of eighth graders took Grade 8 math test

MATH ASSESSMENTS

- While ELA is tested by grade levels from 3-11 grade, math is assessed from grades 3-8 but students are assessed in Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II in the year in which they take the course regardless of their grade level.
- 97% of NJ 7th graders took the grade 7 math assessment as compared to **74% of Berkeley Heights 7th graders.**
- 66% of NJ 8th graders took the grade 8 math assessment as compared to **38% of Berkeley** Heights 8th graders.

SUMMARY

- Berkeley Heights students are taking higher level math courses much sooner than the state averages.
- The students identified to take these math courses while in middle school did well on the PARCC assessment.
- The Grade 8 math scores represent only **38%** of our Grade 8 students.
